CHECK-IN/OUT INFORMATION

The address of Camp Long is **82 Camp Long Road, Aiken, SC.**

Check-in is at Morris Lodge on Sunday, July 12, from 2:00 – 3:00pm (EDT)

Check-out is at Morris Lodge on Saturday, July 19, 11:00 - 11:30am (EDT).

Note for returning campers, the check-in and -out times are slightly later than in previous years.

Check-In Procedures:

When you arrive at-Camp Long, our staff will greet you and administer a COVID test to your camper/s. This area will be clearly marked and visible upon entry. Testing will be done at your car, and we ask each family to stay in their car until the test results come back. After confirmation of a negative test result, our staff will give you a number, like at the DMV style (joy!), and direct you to Morris Lodge.

If your camper's COVID test is positive, we unfortunately cannot accept them. We will remain optimistic that all campers will test negative for COVID, though!

Morris Lodge - Pizza, Official Check-In, and Meet the Camp Health Officer

Once your camper has been tested, you will next go to Morris Lodge to complete the next steps of registration.

When you arrive at Morris Lodge, feel free to take a seat at one of the tables and relax after your drive or socialize with other families while you wait for your number to be called. If you ordered pizza, you can go ahead and get it. We will have a merchandise table available if you would like to purchase anything. If you would like to place an additional order for lunch or merchandise, you can add it to your order on [Active](#) or email Amy Monsky at amy.monsky@camp42.org no later than Thursday, 7/19. Proceeds from all purchases are used to fund camperships, which is financial aid to campers in need. We accept cash, checks, and credit cards.

We invite you to sit down and relax in between your potentially long trip to and from camp as well as get to know some of the other parents and campers.

You will need to visit two stations to complete your camper's check-in. The first will be to check in with camp staff to make sure we have all necessary information and paperwork. If you have ordered extra shirts or merchandise through your Active account, this is where you will get them.

If you have not already submitted your camper's physical, please bring it to this station. You do not need to wait in a line; we will call your number when it is your turn.

The next station to visit is the Camp Health Officer, Nurse Bobbie. We require all campers to visit the Camp Health Officer, whether or not your camper has meds. Like before, we will call your number when it is your turn.

Once you finish talking with Nurse Bobbie, you can move your camper and their luggage into their cabin. Campers in G1 and G2 will be in Thompson Rec at the bottom of the hill, across from Morris.. Campers in all other cabins will be at the top of the hill, and our staff will direct you to the appropriate area.

We ask parents to say their good-byes after their camper is unpacked and settled in. We have a full week of fun planned and we want to get started right away, so we ask that parents have the check-in process completed with good-byes no later than 3:15pm. We understand this part is probably harder for the parents than the campers, so please know that your camper will have a fabulous time at camp! We will do our best to post pictures occasionally throughout the week in our Facebook group.

Letters and care packages may be left at the main check-in table after you have said good-bye to your camper. More information on care packages can be found in the "2026 Camp 42 SC Important Information" document.

Check-Out is also at Morris Lodge.

Check-out Procedures:

YOU MUST COME TO MORRIS LODGE TO CHECK YOUR CAMPER OUT. We need to be fully aware that your campers, who we have happily cared for all week, are solidly back in your care. Please do not give us heart attacks! Please visit the check-out table to officially check your camper out, and then visit the medical officer's table to retrieve any remaining medication.

Please do not leave camp without officially checking your camper out.

It is also important to check the lost and found section in Morris Lodge for any stray items. Every year, we have at least one garbage bag full of items left behind. While we try to encourage campers to look for their items throughout the week, there is inevitably a large number of items left.
